

What is the NHS Digital Staff Passport?

Developed by NHS England and run by NHS trusts, the digital NHS DSP service enables NHS employees to share employment information with NHS trusts 24/7, to support moves between those trusts

What does the NHS DSP do?

The service supports you to securely share essential employment information including pre-employment checks, core skills and occupational health

How does it work?

You will register with a web-based portal, which connects to your Employer's portal via an app on your mobile phone, allowing information to be shared securely

Who can use the NHS DSP?

Temporary Movers

Who remain employed by their current NHS employer and will work at another NHS trust for an agreed period



Postgraduate Doctors in Training

Who rotate between trusts as part of their training programme



Other staff groups

All NHS employees will have the option to use the service in time

How can I use the NHS DSP?

1 Trust(s) registered?



Check your current and next/new trust is registered to use the NHS DSP via beta.staffpassports.nhs.uk

2 Request access

Use the link in the Starter Pack from the Recruitment team

3 Verify identity



- Use *Yoti* or *EasyID (Post Office)* to set up your digital identity* – both are government certified digital identity service providers, approved for use with the NHS DSP
- Share your digital identity with the Recruitment team via the NHS DSP
- Once verified, the Recruitment team will issue you with a digital access key to log in to the NHS DSP

**You can still use the current face to face identity check method*

4 Credentials



- A digital record of an achievement, quality or aspect of a person's background
- Request and receive credentials from your current Recruitment team via the NHS DSP

5 Induction



With credentials shared with another NHS trust via the NHS DSP, you can complete the local induction and start work
